In the request for the graduation application, please specify plans to transfer in your remaining credits by 4/30.

\*\*Students in Grady Health's Radiologic Technology program may send an official transcript from Grady Health to SJC after successful completion of **their fifth semester** as outlined in Grady Health's program map (typically ending in mid-April). Official transcripts must be received by SJC by the last day of April. At that point, if minimum grades have been met, SJC will transfer in the block of 30 semester hour credits and the student will be eligible to have their Associate of Science degree in Radiologic Science Administration conferred in May.

\*\*\*Students must earn a 'C' or better in each course for the course to be eligible to transfer to SJC.

\*\*\*Students must earn a minimum of 18 credits at SJC and 15 credits must be within their major.

\*\*\*Students must complete at least 66 credits in order to receive an Associate Degree.
